- Waterfront Toronto has been working with community stakeholders to develop Urban Design Guidelines and a Transportation Master Plan for the area south of the Lakeshore to Queen's Quay between Yonge and Jarvis, public meeting will be held on October 10
- Still no decision on Federal Electoral Borundaries for Toronto Centre
- Two candidates for the by-election have been determined: Chrystia Freeland (Liberal) and Linda McQuaig (NDP)

Design and Planning Initiatives Project Officer, Parks, Forestry & Recreation
Jennifer spoke (complete with photos, drawings and graphs) of redevelopment plans for Berczy Park and as it
relates to Section 37 of the Planning Act which permits the City to authorize increases in permitted height and/or
density through the zoning bylaw in return for community benefits, provided that there are related Official Plan
policies in place. Also, spoke of Section 42, Cash in lieu of Parkland payment

Edward Nixon – EN Consulting - advised of upcoming Community Consultations re: Berczy Park and distributed a form which provided an opportunity for each person present to complete a "Vision Statement" for the Berczy Park Revitalization
