### ***ROAD CLOSURE - FRONT STREET EAST AUGUST 11*** ***ROAD CLOSURE - MARKET STREET AUGUST 12***

The St. Lawrence Market Neighbourhood BIA is hosting our annual Feast of St. Lawrence this summer in Old Town Toronto. [ [www.feastofstlawrence.com](http://www.feastofstlawrence.com) ]

This event includes two road closures, one on Friday, August 11<sup>th</sup> and one on Saturday, August 12<sup>th</sup>.

We will be closing Front Street East from Scott Street to Church Street on Friday, August 11<sup>th</sup> from 9 a.m. to 2 a.m. Church Street and Scott Street will still be open to vehicular traffic. The event on Front Street (6 p.m. -11 p.m.) is a ticketed 5 course dinner featuring local fare from our restaurants. We will also be licensing the event so the street will be gated off to the general public. The event will include decorations and an unamplified Jazz band. The sidewalks on the south side of Front St. will remain open to accommodate pedestrian traffic.

We are also closing Market Street from Front Street East to Wilton Street on Saturday, August 12<sup>th</sup> from 5:00 a.m. to 12:00 a.m. (The event runs from 10 a.m. - 11 p.m.). Patio furniture will be added and St. Lawrence Market vendors will set-up on the street. Performance spaces will also be set-up along the street showcasing live entertainment and interactive games will take place throughout the day on the street. At 5 p.m. upon market closing, the street will be programmed with some live performances and a DJ. Market Street will be fully licensed. Paid duty police officers as well as private security will be on-site throughout the day to ensure safety.
