Public Consultation: Hours of Operation

You are invited to a public consultation on Hours of Operation for the St. Lawrence Market South Building

The City of Toronto is reviewing the hours of operation of the St. Lawrence Market South Building with the objective of optimizing the hours to better support the Toronto and Market community. The South Market currently operates five days a week, open from 8am-6pm Tuesday through Thursday, 8am-7pm on Fridays and 5am-5pm on Saturdays.

Details are as follows:

Date: Wednesday, October 2, 2019

Time: 7:00pm to 9:00pm Location: Temporary Market

(125 The Esplanade - corner of The Esplanade and Market Street)

- 84% of Visitors (within 5 km) are interested in expanded hours
- Residents (within 5km) with the market more as a tourist attraction than a grocery store
- 61% of customers live within 5 km
 - 26% within 1 km
- 47% of visitors come for a meal
