President's Report – Notes – S. McMillan – November 28, 2018

1. Membership Fee – membership to approve rate proposed by board

MOTION

"That the 2019 SLNA membership fee remain the same as it was for 2018 - \$2.75/unit up to a maximum of \$375 per building/home association - and that the fee for associate members remain at \$30.00 per member."

MOTION PASSED

2. The SLNA has focused on ensuring our new councilors are aware of our priorities – today's meeting is part of our orientation for Councillor Wong-Tam. A little over a week ago our VP Sabina Sormova and myself met with our neighbourhood's other Councillor, Joe Cressy. Key topics we have stressed and continue to stress for our neighbourhood include:
 - a. Improving the safety of our streets in the SL;
 - b. Improving our lack of sufficient green space and working with us to come with solutions
 - c. Mitigating the impact of the Metrolinx expansion work on residents in our neighbourhood;
 - d. The King St. Pilot – we look forward to learning more about the year to date data and how we can improve the pilot so that it remains to benefit residents and businesses.
 - e. We are seeking from our Councillors clarity on the strategy for addressing Homelessness in the area;
 - f. Remember the North Market - we've been waiting a long time and we hope this will move forward with some haste;
 - g. Our neighbourhood is in demand. People want to move here and we want to ensure that the city dedicates sufficient resources to reinforcing our Infrastructure so that it can adequately handle growth in this area.
 - h. We've also mentioned to both Councillors the importance of protecting our section 37 funds
3. Quick update – I sent around the results from the Consultation we participated in as an Association regarding proposed plans for development at One Front St. West. Hopefully you all had a chance to review it. It's helpful to see the feedback shared by your neighbours and just so you know the developer hopes to come back and speak with us in January.
4. Holiday Decorations – east of Sherbourne along The Esplanade has been devoid of decorations. The Board approved \$500 to be spent on decorations and the BIA was kind enough to secure decorations and install on light poles in that area for the SLNA.
5. There will be a Reading of Dickens A Christmas Carol at our local Library on December 6 in the evening at 6:30 pm. Our Librarian Dulce is coordinating this local production and I'm so pleased

to be one of the readers along with other residents in the area.
