### SLNA COMMITTEES

<b>Development</b>	SLNA members participating in discussions with developer on Sobey's site development (Front St East). Ideally no OMB hearing will be required.
<b>First Parliament Site</b>	Motion approved April 29 <sup>th</sup> 2015: "be it resolved that the St. Lawrence Neighbourhood Association supports the unified development of Canada's First Parliament Site and urges all participants... to ensure that this site is sensitively developed and returned to public use as soon as possible."
<b>Gardiner East</b>	SLNA supports community recommendation to remove Gardiner East of Jarvis. Visit <a href="http://www.gardinereast.ca">www.gardinereast.ca</a>
<b>North Market</b>	Transition to temporary south market location in June, construction on new North building starting summer 2015 with an architectural dig. Build will take approx. 18 months.
<b>Community Policing Liaison Committee for 51Div</b>	Pan Am/Parapan Am: Multi, regional/organizational security operations have already begun throughout south and central Ontario. Athletes Village opens to security June 26 <sup>th</sup> , 2015; security closes 22 <sup>nd</sup> August 2015 (PPAm close: 15 <sup>th</sup> August).
